We will once again be offering the 2017 BMW Raffle again with tickets available to sell as of **July 1st** and the draw will be in December (date still to be finalized).



2017 Special Olympics World Winter Games and Team Canada

Team Canada competed in six winter sports: alpine skiing, cross country (Nordic) skiing, figure skating, floor hockey, speed skating and snowshoeing and took home 171 medals: **61 gold, 81 silver and 29 bronze.**

From this incredible medal haul, Alberta athletes brought their best game faces and are coming home with 16 medals (eight gold, five silver and three bronze) in cross country, speed skating and figure skating.

Not only did they break personal bests, they represented Canada with grace and true sportsmanship, sharing the joy of wins not just for their fellow teammates, but also for their competitors.
