



Respect in Sport RiS – Sask Sport Inc.

Special Olympics Saskatchewan is under the governance of the Sask Sport Inc. organization, and is responsible to comply with all of the processes and procedures that are deemed necessary for the safety of our athletes and the enhancement of the sport programming that is being offered to our membership.

Special Olympics Saskatchewan is committed to creating a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity. Coaches and volunteers have a responsibility to create a sporting environment that is free of harassment, abuse, bullying and neglect.

OVERVIEW

Respect in Sport provides an overview of the potential issues and circumstances that one may face while participating in any sport program, how to identify certain behaviours, and what to do in a case where a situation may arise.

The Respect in Sport training is required to be completed by <u>all</u> volunteers who are considering taking on a leadership role within Special Olympics. Whether it be as a coach, assistant coach, an ongoing/weekly program volunteer, community executive member, and/or as a support while traveling or at any competition.

HOW TO COMPLETE RIS

- 1. Go to https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/
- 2. Under 'Getting Started', click the box that applies to you.
- 3. Follow the subsequent links and instructions if you are already certified and looking to make changes or are looking to re-certify.
- 4. If you are New to this program? Select the 'Click here to register now' box.
- 5. Select 'New User, I have never taken one of these programs before'
- 6. Enter your personal information
- 7. For "Association", click on the plus symbol to expand selections, then select **Special Olympics Saskatchewan**
- 8. Enter your account information
- 9. Click **I'm not a Robot**
- 10. For "Communication to the NCCP", click Allow
- 11. Click **Submit Registration**
- 12. Read the instructions and click on **Program Access** to begin





The on-line course is set up in six short modules. You do not have to complete all the modules at one time. You can choose to complete one or two modules in one sitting and re-access the website another day to continue.

To re-access the website, follow the same instructions 1 and 2 above, then login with your username and password, then click on **Program Access** and select your next module.

CERTIFICATION

After the modules have been completed, you will receive an email stating that you have successfully completed the program along with a certification number and certificate.
