

SOC Orientation Course

The SOC Orientation Course is required for all volunteers with Special Olympics Saskatchewan.

This online training is divided into four modules, followed by a knowledge check, to help orient you as a volunteer with Special Olympics Canada. Each module is designed to provide information about the history and mission of the Special Olympics, your role as a volunteer, an introduction to working with our athletes, and how to create safe and positive sport environments.

This course takes approximately 30 minutes to complete. The modules do not have to be completed in one sitting, so you are free to pause and return to the course at any time. You can also access the course again after completing it to review the information.

Have fun, and thank you for the time, energy, and commitment you are dedicating to Special Olympics!

How to complete the SOC Orientation Course

1. Visit <http://solearn.ca/login/index.php>
2. If you do not have an account, click "Create New Account" and follow the prompts. If you already have an account, simply log in.
3. Click the "Orientation" heading at the top of the homepage, located directly below "Start Here!"
4. Click "Special Olympics Canada Volunteer Orientation."
5. Select either the "English Course" or "Cours Français", depending on your preferred language.
6. Ensure "Normal" mode is selected, then click "Enter."
7. Click "Access Module" to begin the course.
8. Complete each module, beginning with Overview and finishing with the Knowledge Check.
9. As you progress through the course, you will notice the border of the circle beside each module gradually filling with red. Once a module has been completed, the circle will become solid red with a white checkmark (see image below).



10. Once you have successfully passed the Knowledge Check, you will receive your Certificate of Completion via email. Please save a copy of your certificate and send it to your local Special Olympics Community. You can also access your certificate at any time by logging back into the course.
