

## NCCP & Special Olympics Canada eLearning Modules

The National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) and Special Olympics Canada (SOC) offer a range of online learning modules designed to enhance coaches' knowledge, skills, and abilities. These modules are available through your online NCCP account under the eLearning section.

### How to Access the NCCP & SOC Online Modules

1. Go to The Locker [login](#) page.
2. Log in using your NCCP number (or email address) and password.
  - If you do not know your NCCP number or password, please contact the Special Olympics Saskatchewan Director of Community, Programs and Operations for assistance.
  - Please do not create a new account.

3. Once logged in, click eLearning in the navigation bar.
4. You will be directed to the NCCP Multi-Sport Online Modules.
5. To access the Special Olympics Canada modules, select the "Multi-Sport" box and then choose "Special Olympics" from the list of sports.

The following NCCP Multi-Sport modules are free:

## **NCCP Modules with a Fee**

NCCP also offers additional multi-Sport modules that require a fee.

While these modules have a cost, your Special Olympics community may cover them as part of coach development. Please contact your Community Executive Committee to determine whether reimbursement is available.

1. Coaching Athletes with a Disability - \$15
2. Coach Initiation in Sport - \$15
3. Creating a Positive Sport Environment – \$15
4. Decision Making for Officials - \$20
5. Leading Drug-Free Sport - \$50
6. Managing Conflict - (*Cost and delivery vary by province/territory*)
7. Sport Nutrition - \$20
8. Make Ethical Decisions - \$85 (*Required for all Special Olympics Saskatchewan coaches and volunteers*)
