To step up to the challenge of competing in the 2019 Special Olympics Truck Pull, assemble a team of eight members and register today! Teams compete to be the fastest at pulling a 15 tonne semi for 15 metres! Each team will run two heats. *Win prizes in four different categories - best pull time for male/female/co-ed and most spirited team. Your team is sure to have a blast!*

# Rules and Team Information

1. All participants must have signed and submitted a waiver before participating in the Truck Pull.
2. Teams must have a minimum eight participants. Co-ed teams must consist of at least two females.
3. Teams can have up to 12 participants but *only* eight people are allowed to pull at one time. The rest of the team will be responsible for moral support, leading the crowd in cheering, and being prepared to replace a puller in case of injury or emergency.
4. Each team will have two heats with the fastest time being recorded.
5. No participant substitutions can be made after the first pull unless injury or emergency.
6. Before the pull, the rope must be held in place.
7. Once all wheels of the truck cab have been pulled past the 15 metre mark, the timer will stop and your team can stop pulling.
8. In the event of a tie, both of the team's second times will be used to determine the winner.
9. Participants are required to wear gloves to protect their hands. Gloves will be provided. No weight belts to fasten to the rope are allowed. Flip flops are prohibited.
10. The event will take place rain or shine.
11. All participants must pay their registration fee prior to participating.
12. All participants will receive a complimentary BBQ lunch and Truck Pull t-shirt!
