Nominations

Award Criteria

- The nominee must be an active registered volunteer with Special Olympics PEI.
- The nominee must be involved in Special Olympics program(s) throughout the year.
- The nominee must have attended a provincial qualifying event, national games or international games.
- The nominee must demonstrate fair play, show leadership and be a good role model for other coaches/volunteers and athletes.
- The nominee must be committed to coach education and personal development.
