## Investor beware

"Phenomenal opportunity, high returns, low minimum investments, offshore, independent financial groups, \$billions changing hands in minutes", that's some of the bait used in this scam. Saskatchewan residents are warned not to invest in Banner Fund International or Swiss Trade & Commerce Trust operated out of Belize City, Belize. This offshore investment scheme requires a \$200 minimum investment which is pooled allowing the "little guy" to play with the big boys, reaping "major returns" through leverage coupled with arbitrage". The scheme is illegal because it does not meet the requirements of the Securities Act.
