



Special Olympics BC Fundraising Events Volunteers

Summary

The Fund Development team at Special Olympics BC is seeking a group of volunteers to support fundraising and community engagement events. These events occur throughout the year and across the province. Events may include SOBC's proprietary fundraising events (such as Auction for Athletes, SOBC Classic, Sports Celebrities Festival) and third-party initiatives (such as the Law Enforcement Torch Run and other LETR-led initiatives, the Polar Plunge, motionball/motionballU).

Duties and Responsibilities may include:

- Fulfilling various event volunteer roles on-site including registration, guest relations and event coordination and logistics.
- Performing various administrative tasks associated with event planning.
- Acting as the Special Olympics BC representative at events.
- Acting as the liaison for Special Olympics BC athletes attending events.

Requirements

- Must register as a volunteer with Special Olympics BC, which includes a criminal record check.

Commitment

- Casual, ongoing.
- Approximately 20-40 hours per year, however the time commitment for each event varies – events may take place over a couple hours or a full day.
- Opportunities will be dispersed as they arise, and volunteers can indicate their availability for each event.

Location

- Events occur throughout the province, with the majority taking place in the Lower Mainland
