Current Guidelines for Special Olympics Saskatchewan Gatherings

Based on the Province of Saskatchewan's requirements regarding mask wearing and proof of vaccinations, Special Olympics Saskatchewan (SOS) has updated our guidelines.

These requirements are <u>current and fluid</u>. SOS will continue to evaluate and adapt as new information becomes available, always keeping the health and safety of our athletes, and all stakeholders, as the highest priority.

Mask Requirement Effective until March 1, 2022

- All athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, staff, family, and spectators participating in or attending any Special Olympics in-person gathering will be required to wear a mask at all times unless stated below.
 - o Who can remove their mask and when
 - SOS athletes may remove their masks on the field of play.
 - o Facilities and coaching staff also reserve the right to request that masks remain on at all times.
