Both Alpine and Cross Country Skiing will be part of the 1994 Saskatchewan Winter Games.

To be eligible to participate in Alpine, competitors must be a Saski Club member, National Card Holder and be born in 1975 through to 1982. There will be three classes of competition held during the second half of the Games (Feb. 16-19).

Competitors in Cross Country skiing must hold a Saskatchewan or Canadian Racing Licence and be a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Saskatchewan Ski Association. There are three age classifications for boys and girls, including Midget (13 and under), Juvenile (15 and under), and Junior (17 and under).

Special Olympic competitors must be 29 and under as of Sept. 1, 1993, with one man and one woman comprising the Zone 5 team.

For both Alpine and Cross Country skiing, six men and six women, plus one coach and one manager, respectively, will make up the Zone 5 team.
