

Local groups show support for Special Olympics

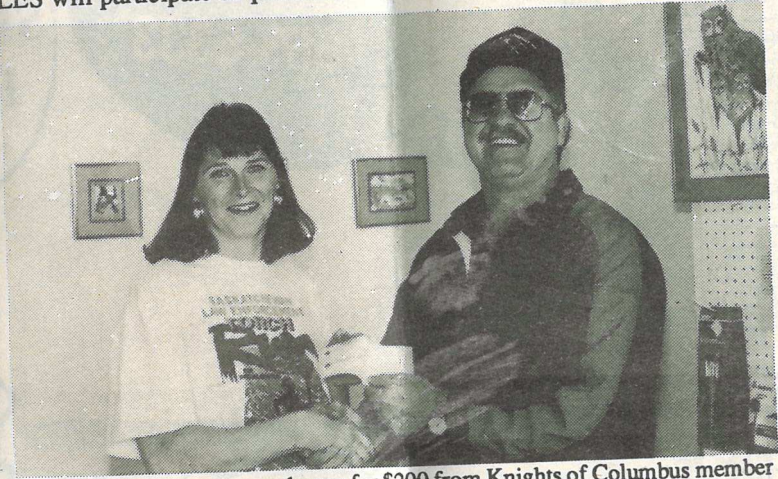
