

Law enforcement officers to raise funds for Special Olympics

Saskatchewan's law enforcement agencies are participating in various activities to raise money for this weekend's Special Olympics provincial summer games in Prince Albert.

This week is the 10th annual Law Enforcement Torch Run, which has raised more than \$500,000 for the Special Olympics.

Prince Albert's police employees are scheduled to serve coffee Thursday at Robin's Donuts. The proceeds from the coffee sales will be donated to Special Olympics. Customers who have purchased a coffee or a meal that day will be eli-

gible for hourly door prizes.

Representatives from various law enforcement agencies are also participating in a run into Prince Albert Friday afternoon.
