

# Special Olympics campaign starts

Students will be lacing up their sneakers for the fifth annual provincial youth relay for Saskatchewan Special Olympics on June 3.

Twelve- to 19-year-old students from across the province are invited to help raise money for the Saskatchewan Special Olympics Society.

Students recruit sponsorship for their participation in an eight-hour relay which is being held at the RCMP Training Academy in Regina. The opening ceremonies will begin at 9:30 a.m. with the relay taking place 10 a.m.-6 p.m.

In addition to raising money, organizers of the youth relay hope to raise awareness of Special Olympic programs among Saskatchewan youth.

The Saskatchewan Special Olympics Society raises money to contribute to the physical, social and psychological development of mentally handicapped people.

The 1995 fund-raising goal for the relay is \$10,000. All the money raised during the relay goes to the Saskatchewan Special Olympics Society. Administrative and operational costs are paid for by corporate sponsors.
