

Special Olympics in Regina

Saskatchewan Association for the Mentally Retarded and the Knights of Columbus will co-sponsor 200 athletes in the Saskatchewan Special Olympics today and Saturday in Regina.

Events lined up include five pin bowling, 25-metres and 50-metres swim races including a 100-metre relay and track and field events.

The bowling and swimming events will be run this evening, both scheduled to begin at 7 p.m. Bowlers will meet at the Bolodrome while the swimmers compete at the university pool.

Track and field events will be run Saturday at Douglas Park with the opening ceremonies and parade to begin at 10:30 a.m. Activities get underway at 11 p.m. with races, broad jump, high jump, softball throw and relays. Five age groups from nine, to 18 and over will be competing in the weekend events.

Sports activities end at 2:30 Saturday with closing ceremonies at Douglas Park.
