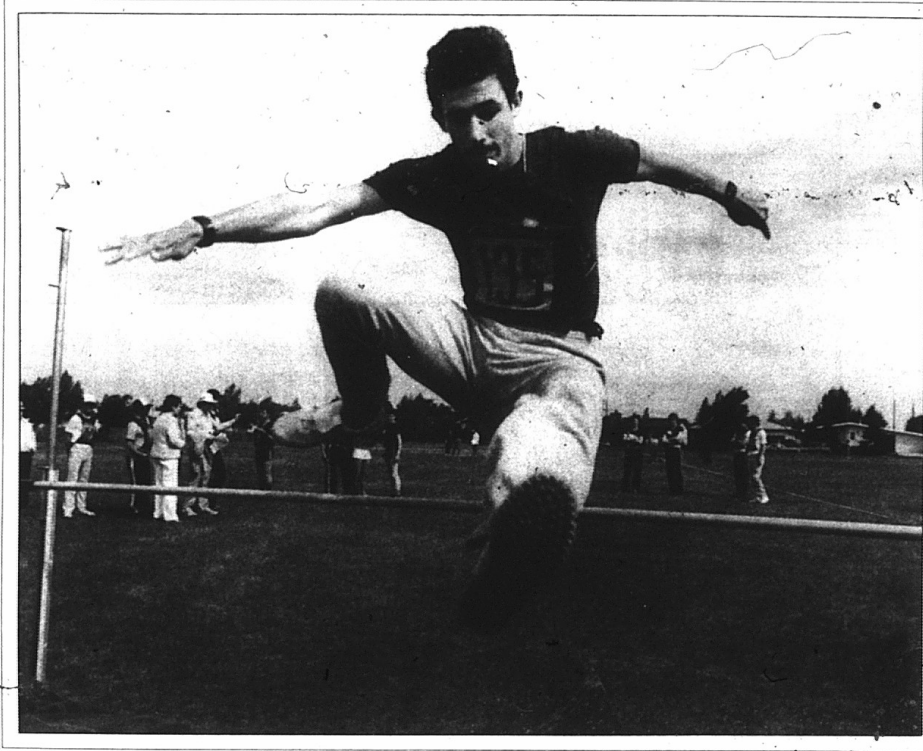

The 1986 Special Olympics Provincial Summer Games



Friday and Saturday, June 20, 21

Special Olympics is a non-profit organization committed to improving the quality of life for mentally handicapped people by providing fitness, recreation and sport opportunities for handicapped individuals regardless of disability level.

Saskatchewan Special Olympics began in 1969 through the efforts of the Knights of Columbus and the Saskatchewan Association for the Mentally Retarded to provide sport and recreation opportunities to mentally handicapped individuals. In 1965 the Special Olympics Society was formed.

Today ongoing programs lead to competitions on regional, provincial, national and international levels. In Saskatchewan there are

eight zones which hold organized activities. Winners in the zone games then represent their region in the provincial Special Olympics. Saskatchewan Special Olympics is supported by Saskatchewan Culture & Recreation, Sask Sport and Saskatchewan Lotteries.

This year a Superathlete Event will be held in which eight Special Olympic athletes will be teamed with eight professional sports figures (Saskatchewan celebrities). Each team will compete in three track and field events.

Everyone in Saskatchewan is urged to come out and support these special people on June 20, 21.
