

Special Olympics under way

Rick of North Battleford was the individual standout at the Saskatchewan Special Olympics swimming events Friday night at the University Pool.

Kenny, competing in the group C level one division, had the fastest times of the night, swimming the 25-metres in 0:19.4 and the 50-metres 0:46.8.

Another North Battleford swimmer, Sonya, had the two fastest times in the girls' division with times of 0:23.8 in the 25-metres and 0:56.4 in the 50-metres. Sonya competed in the girls' group C level two division.

North Battleford and Moose Jaw had the most double-winners, three each. Prince Albert had two and Regina and Saskatoon one each.

Laurel, competing in the girls' group D level two division, was North Battleford's other double winner.

Moose Jaw double winners were Carol Ann in the girls' group D level two division, Theresa in the girls' group E, level one division and Randy in the boys' group B level two division.

Prince Albert's double-winners were Richard in boys' group A level one and Dale in boys' group E level one.

Jeff, competing in boys' group C level two, was Regina's double-winner and Saskatoon's double-winner was Rick, competing in the boys' group D level one.

North Battleford won the 100-metre relay, finishing ahead of Regina and Saskatoon.

However, all the competitors were winners Friday.
