COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

During Competition:

- Vaccine passports will be checked upon arrival.
- Masks will be worn at all times except while actively curling, eating or drinking.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the venue.
- Designated areas will be appointed to each team and signage visible, to insure social distancing while not competing.
- Rock handles will be sanitized at the start of each game.
- A separate, private room is available if teams would like to eat their lunch there. This room is large and social distancing will not be an issue.
- Any spectators will need to show their vaccine passport before entering.
- All volunteers will have had their vaccine passport checked and proof recorded.

Buffet Dinner:

- The Golf and Curling Club Restaurant is a large space and social distancing will not be an issue. If we feel the need to further distance between the tables we have the ability to open a sliding wall and use moving partitions to maintain group privacy.
- Hand sanitizer will be available upon arrival.
- Tables will have signs and be designated for each team with settings of 6 (there will be space to add a place setting for an extra coach or spare player) Tables will be spaced 3 m apart.
- Masks will be worn any time a person is not sitting at their table.
- To avoid line ups and congestion at the buffet table, each team will be invited up individually and be seated before next team is called up.
- Any prizes will be delivered by volunteers to avoid extra moving around.
- Vaccine passports will be required to attend the dinner.
