

Police begin torch run

PRINCE ALBERT (CP)—More than 800 police officers are taking part in a week-long annual torch run to raise money for the Saskatchewan Special Olympics.

The torch run involves officers from 22 police departments around Saskatchewan.

Organizers hope to raise \$100,000, said RCMP Corp. Dave Hoeft.

The event began Monday in Prince Albert National Park and will end Friday in Weyburn, the site of this year's Special Olympics.
