TEAM BC MEDICAL...WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW!

Team BC will be travelling with Medical Mission Staff member Carla Zilkowsky. Carla has over 30 years of experience as a Registered Nurse and Paramedic, so be assured our team will be in great hands should any medical issues arise!

While at the Games, the Games Organizing Committee (GOC) will have poly clinics set up to deal with all medical issues. Should an athlete require hospitalization, the GOC's medical team will make the call and, along with the Team BC mission staff and medical officer will transport the athlete to hospital (if it is an emergency, they will call the ambulance).

Once the athlete has been looked at and an assessment made, depending on what is found, the Best Contact for the athlete will be notified. If you are at the Games, every attempt will be made to contact you once the assessment has been made!

MAXIMUM PERFORMANCE RULE (MPR)

For our Supporters attending Games, we want to provide some information on some competition processes that will be in effect at the Games. For these Games, MPR will apply to the sports of cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and speedskating, all events that will have both a preliminary and then final race.

One of the unique things about Special Olympics competition is that athletes are placed in "divisions" so they compete against athletes of similar ability. People often refer to divisioning as creating the best competition in sport. However, in reality, the athletes must be putting in their best effort, or maximum performance, at all times and that is why MPR was created.

MPR comes in effect if an athlete improves on their preliminary time in the final event by 15% or greater. In such cases the MPR would re-division the athlete into the correct division as indicated by their final time. Although the athlete would still win a medal if their time warrants in the new division, they will not receive any selection points for that event to advance for selection to higher levels of competition.
