Take On The Challenge!

Join our *compassionate army* of truck drives and be a part of the **Truck Convoy for Special Olympics Saskatchewan**. On Saturday, September 12th, 2020, Saskatchewan Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR) officers will escort the Truck Convoy in two separate convoys, one in Regina and the other in Saskatoon, to raise awareness and funds for Special Olympics Saskatchewan Athletes. Join in and help change attitudes towards people with intellectual disabilities.

Trucks will meet in either Regina or Saskatoon for the beginning of the Convoy! Trucks are then escorted by LETR Officers around the selected city. The event will conclude in the same location as the Convoy began.

One free breakfast is included in your registration, if you are bringing a family member with you on the convoy, please include in "Convoy Registration" below if any additional breakfast orders are required. (Each additional breakfast is \$5)

Types of Vehicles Allowed

We welcome all types of vehicles, including semi-trucks, truck/trailer combinations, large trucks, low-boys, dump trucks, flat beds, buses, tow trucks, large box trucks, and more.

Please note, no hazardous materials or over dimensional combinations are allowed.

How to Participate

To participate, truckers must fill out a registration form and submit their registration fee of \$100 payable to "Special Olympics Saskatchewan". A pledge form is included in this package for drivers able to raise additional money in an effort to secure the **LEAD TRUCK POSITION** in the Convoy. The driver who raises the most pledges will be awarded this prestigious position! There is also the option to register online and collect pledges via the online fundraising page found at SaskConvoy.ca!

How to be Lead Truck

The lead Truck position goes to the individual trucker who raises the highest total of pledge dollars with his/her individual registration. In order to be eligible, all Pledge Forms must be mailed (1121 Winnipeg Street, Regina, SK, S4R 1J5) or emailed (sengland@specialolympics.sk.ca) to the Special Olympics Saskatchewan office prior to September 12th.
