Win medals at Special Olympics

Three employees at Mallard Industries in Wadena were awarded three gold and four silver medals at the Provincial Special Olympics Winter Games held at Melfort on Saturday, Feb. 13.

Carol Strom, Dale Pearson and Clayton Pirie represented Zone 5 in the snowshoeing and cross-country

skiing events.

Carol and Clayton competed in the snowshoe event where Carol received gold medals in the 100m and 400m and silver in the 200m. Clayton won a silver medal in the 100m and a gold in the 200m race. Dale was awarded two silver medals in the 100m and 400m crosscountry skiing events. Dale also competed in the 1 km race but had trouble keeping his skis on.
