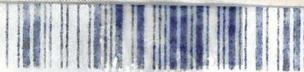
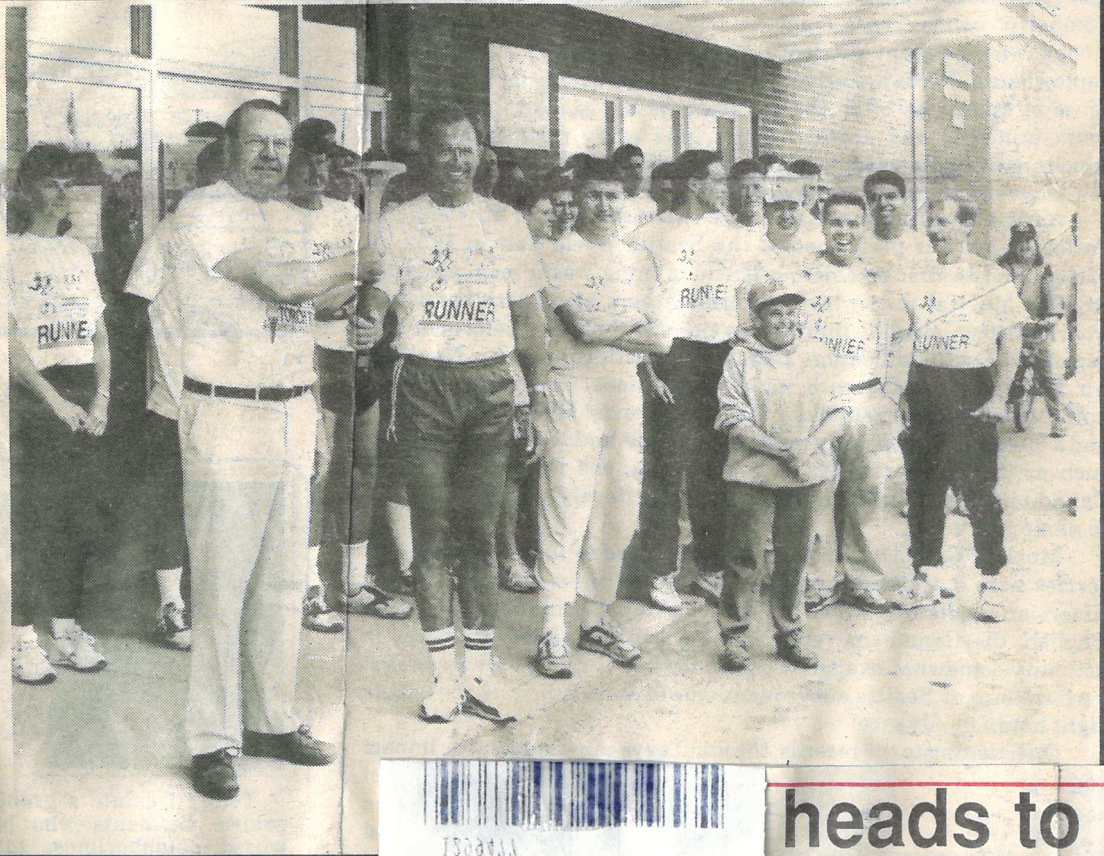
The 1993 Law Enforcement Torch Run

got underway last Thursday morning from the Watrous Civic Center. Mayor Murray Westby (left, foreground) was on hand to officially pass the torch to the runners, represented by Cst. Dave Hiebert of Watrous Detachment.

The group was comprised of RCMP and Civilian Members from Watrous, Imperial, and Saskatoon. They were slated to run to Saskatoon and meet with other groups from the Corrections Branch and RCMP Radisson— the torch eventually ended up at Regina where this year's Special Olympics were held, and for which the Torch Run generates funding.

Saskatoon Sub/Division raised about \$10,000 for the Olympics, of which Cst. Hiebert himself accounted for \$5,100!
