

# Special O bike B 6317 poker run planned

A fund-raising motorcycle poker run will take place, based from Weyburn, on Saturday, May 13.

The motorcycle poker run will take a similar format to snowmobile poker rallies, with the motorcyclists leaving Weyburn between noon and 1 p.m. They will travel to Midale, Estevan, then to Stoughton and back to Weyburn to the Elks Hall, with the riders drawing a card at each stop.

Half of the money raised will go to the Special Olympics, as well as \$2 from each steak supper sold at the Elks, said one of the organizers, Russ Moe. The balance of the money raised will be split up among the poker run winners.

He said some years the poker run is done in conjunction with their toy run for the Salvation Army at Christmas, but this year it was decided to do a separate run for the Special Olympics. The toy run will still be held later this fall.

Based on runs held in past years, the attendance could be anywhere from 25 to 50 bikers, depending on the weather and on seeding, said Mr. Moe.
