

Could be close shave for Special Olympic torch run

At least one Weyburn law enforcement officer is willing to put his money where his mouth is — or close to it — to raise money for the Special Olympics.

Local torch run organizer Sgt. Mike Rogal of the Weyburn Police Service has agreed to shave his moustache, which has been part of his upper lip for the last 22 years, if his fellow Weyburn Legion members raise \$150 for the

June 11 run.

Weyburn area law enforcement officers will begin their fundraising efforts with a hot dog and coke sale on Thursday, June 3.

Last year, local law enforcement participants raised nearly \$4,000 through their efforts. This year they are also planning to sell T-shirts and pins to raise money for the event.
