

H6317 Entries lined up for Monday fair parade

With nearly 60 entries lined up, Monday's Chamber of Commerce fair parade is ready to go.

After extending the entry deadline, parade organizer Cindy Herberholz said another 15 attractions were recently added to annual event.

Highlights include the Heart and Stroke Foundation's 30-seat Heartbeat tour bike, a CP Rail speeder converted to ground use, and local Special Olympians on a Clydesdale-propelled float, said Mrs. Herberholz.

Recent rainy weather has parade organizers somewhat concerned about the fate of the parade, she said, but Tuesday is scheduled as an alternate date in case of a rain-out Monday.

With no contingent plans in place, last year's parade was cancelled be-

cause of rain.

The route

This year the parade will line up 9:30 a.m. at the junction of Fifth Avenue North and Fifth Street.

At 10:30, the parade will move on past the Weyburn Special Care hospital along Fifth Street to First Avenue to General Hospital, then south on Second Street to Prairie Avenue and east front of the courthouse.

The route continues south on Third Street, through downtown to Railway Avenue and then on to Second Street north to Bison and west to Government Road.

Parade participants can then proceed to the fairgrounds, continue to the Souris Valley Regional Care Centre, and depart.
