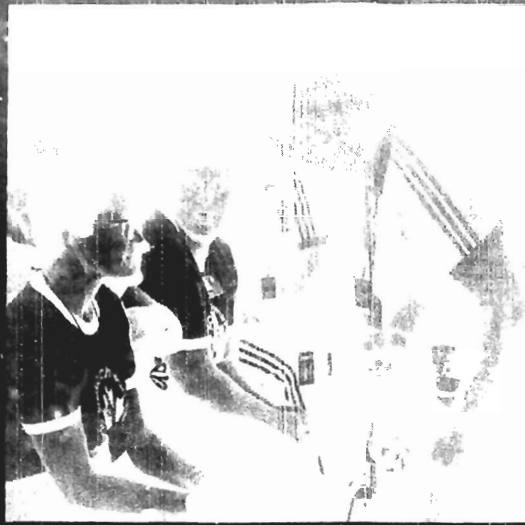


At the Special Olympics
