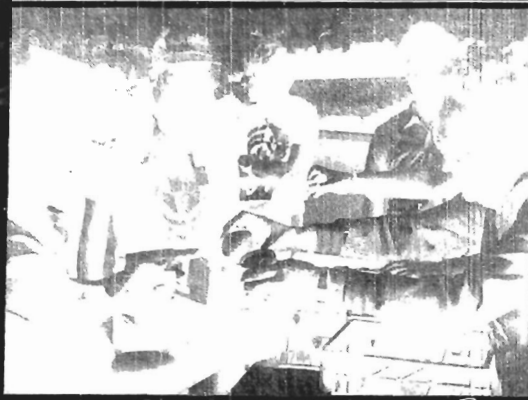


This participant of the games puts his arm out to help soften the landing after clearing the high jump bar in the track and field portion of the games.
