

# Esterhazy hosts Zone 4 Games

Esterhazy is today hosting the Zone 4 Special Olympics.

The one-day track and field competition will see about 65 athletes from six centres in the zone competing for the right to advance to the provincial Special Olympics June 17 to 19 in Yorkton.

Handicapped athletes from Yorkton, Melville, Stenen, Kamsack, Langenburg and Esterhazy will compete in seven events, with each athlete required to enter at least three events and no more than

five.

The games will be held on the grounds of P.J. Gillen Elementary School in Esterhazy, and include the 50 metre dash, 100 metre dash, softball throw, standing long jump, running long jump, high jump and soccer kick.
